SUBJECT: DISASTER ASSISTANCE GUIDANCE (HURRICANE IAN)

## 1. PURPOSE.

To provide \$600 grant for Disaster Assistance to eligible members who are in the path of Hurricane lan in Florida. Eligible service member and their families with a financial need may be provided assistance for evacuation expenses associated with lodging, food, gas and any other essential items. These Disaster Assistance grant applies to those who received evacuation orders (verbal or written) by Installation Commander or local municipal.

## 2. ELIGIBILITY.

- a. Active Duty and their eligible family members.
- b. Air National Guard, AF Reserve (regardless of duty status) and their eligible family members.
- c. **Retirees** receiving retired pay and their eligible family members.
- d. **Medically Retired** and their dependents, including those placed on the Permanent Disability Retired List (PDRL) or Temporary Disability Retirement List (TDRL).
- e. **Surviving Spouses and Children** of who died while on Active Duty (including those on Title 10 Orders) or in an eligible Retired status.

# 3. GENERAL GUIDELINES.

- a. Assistance will be provided as a Grant (\$600).
- b. Assistance is "needs based".
- d. No budget required.

#### 4. PROCEDURE.

- a. Assistance will be considered for <u>individuals who have been ordered to evacuate</u> via a local municipal mandatory evacuation order. Mandatory evacuation information by County for the State of Florida can be found at <u>www.floridadisaster.org/evacuation-orders/.</u>
- b. Installation Commander at MacDill AFB, FL issued a mandatory evacuation/base closure and an official Limited Evacuation Order (LEO). Active duty service members are authorized the use of the Government Travel Card for this emergency and therefore are not considered for this grant.
- c. Eligible members may **apply** through American Red Cross (877-272-7337).
- d. Eligible members may also apply through AFAS HQ but must call 703-972-2604 for guidance on how to apply.
- e. Caseworkers, other Military Relief Societies and American Red Cross **Blanket Authority for \$600 grant authorized**.

# 5. MANDATORY DOCUMENTS.

- a. Application
- b. Military ID
- c. LES
- d. Proof of residency (utility bill, driver's license, etc.)
- e. Special Power of Attorney (spouse)
- 6. This assistance will remain in effect until 7 October 2022. Eligible members requiring additional assistance may submit a separate application.
