You have requested to attend the Motorcycle Safety Foundation (MSF) training course required for all military members and DOD civilians whom are required to operate a motorcycle for their official duties. Failure to attend the requested course without at least 48 hours notification to the Wing Safety Office will result in a "No-Show" letter being sent to your commander. **Initial:** _____

2. For Air Force personnel specific personal protective equipment (PPE) requirements are detailed in AFI 91-207, AFI 91-207_AMC Supplement and in accordance with local installation policies and regulations. It is the operator's responsibility to understand and comply with established regulations. All other service members are required to follow the regulations and guidance established by their governing service. Failure to do so can result in disciplinary actions based on commander's discretion. **Initial:** _____

3. During the courses, students are required to wear personal protective equipment consisting of the following:

- Full fingered gloves, or mittens designed for use on motorcycles.
- Long trousers.
- Long sleeved shirt or jacket.
- Sturdy footwear: Leather boots or other over-the-ankle sturdy shoe.
- Proper eye protection (i.e., impact or shatter resistant clear glasses/goggles).
- High visibility garments (Fluorescent yellow-green, fluorescent orange-red, etc) during the day and reflective at night.
- Students wearing other than conforming PPE and clothing will not be permitted to participate in classes

**** Helmets are provided for BRC classes only; however, you may choose to bring your own DOT/Snell approved helmet if you choose but must be ¾ or full face protection. Initial:** _____

4. The BRC is a two and a half-day course designed for riders with little to no experience. For individuals seeking a Florida State motorcycle endorsement this course is mandatory. Members seeking endorsement outside of Florida must contact their DMV for specific information and requirements. **MOTORCYCLES ARE PROVIDED FOR THE BRC ONLY. Initial:** _____

5. **Students on Stand-By:** Those placed on stand-by are listed on the roster as to what order they are able to replace students that do not show. If you are unable to get into the course as a stand-by student, you **must** notify your MSR, so they can notify the safety office. You **cannot** just show up for the next course and assume you are at the top of the stand by list, or assume you are automatically placed on the roster for the next available course. **Initial:** _____
