## STATEMENT OF WORK

# STATEMENT OF WORK PROCUREMENT, LOGISTICS AND SUSTAINMENT SUPPORT OF BLUE FORCE TRACKING (BFT) ITEMS

#### 1.0 SCOPE

This Statement of Work (SOW) describes supplies, services, and support to be provided by the contractor in support of Special Operations Forces (SOF) Blue Force Tracking (BFT). The BFT effort and this contract will be managed by USSOCOM Program Manager, Command, Control and Communications (PMC3), the BFT Deputy PM (DPM) and the Contracting Officer.

## 2.0 REQUIREMENTS

#### 2.1 PROGRAM MANAGEMENT

The contractor shall provide a Program Manager who will serve as the contractor point-of-contact to manage this effort, provide deliverables and feedback, and resolve issues

#### 2.2 CONTRACTOR LOGISTICS SUPPORT

The Contractor shall furnish all qualified labor, supervision, materials, equipment, tools, appliances, and services to repair the BFT items. Repair shall be performed at the Contractor's facility. The Contractor shall repair the MTX as soon as possible dependent upon resource and part availability. If the repair is expected to take longer than 60 days, GDC4S will contact the Government Point of Contact (POC) and provide a completion date. Each maintenance action shall be recorded and billed at a firm-fixed price established in Section B of this contract. The Government shall pay to ship failed systems to the Contractor's facility. The Contractor shall pay for shipping the repaired systems back to the Government (owning organization), through the shipping CLIN.

- a. Prior to beginning any repair on SOF BFT assets in support of this SOW, the Contractor shall request and the Government shall provide, via e-mail, authorization to proceed. The email authorization will include a specific reference to the system serial number. The Contractor will not be compensated for repairs accomplished on non-SOF assets or without Government authorization.
- b. The Contractor shall repair the item on a firm-fixed price basis as identified in Section B of the contract. Upon written (e-mail) approval of the estimate, the Contractor will complete the repair. Contractor repair procedures shall include test, teardown, evaluation, cleaning, repair actions, functionally testing, upgrading, and preparing for shipment. If the Government decides the item is beyond economical repair then the Government will provide disposition instructions to the Contractor. Unserviceable items and components may be replaced with an item of a higher revision level. Items and components provided as replacement parts must be compatible with all interfacing components of the existing system.
- c. All repairs shall be in accordance with the Contractor's established shop methods and procedures and shall be accomplished with the special tools and test equipment developed and/or provided as GFE for this purpose. The Contractor shall maintain a relationship with the provider of the GFE equipment and notify the BFT DPM if there is any change in the status or availability of that GFE. All repaired equipment shall comply with the requirements of this contract.
- d. The terms "serviceable condition" and "serviceable", as used herein, mean that condition in which an item is capable of meeting all initial operational and functional requirements. Minor cosmetic defects, which do not affect the installation and operation of the items, do not require correction or repair.
- e. Any approved modification to items required or allowed by the contract and not previously accomplished shall be done by the Contractor at the time of repair. Each modified item shall meet form, fit, and function of the item for

which it was modified or changed and be two-way interchangeable (i.e. unmodified items shall operate in place of modified items and modified items shall operate in place of unmodified items).

f. The Contractor shall be responsible for the initial lay-in of piece parts and for obtaining replenishment units and spare piece parts required for use in the repair of failed items. These parts shall remain the property of the Contractor until incorporated into the failed items at which time they become Government property. All parts removed during repair become the property of the Contractor. Used/salvaged parts can be used for repairs.

#### 2.3.1 Reserved

#### 2.3.2 Turn-In Procedures

The following procedures shall be used to turn in items to the Contractor for repair. These procedures apply to USSOCOM users after the BFT DPM has been notified and has authorized the turn-in.

Step 1. The user ships the non-functioning items(s) to the following address:

General Dynamics M/D H1223 (ATTN: MTX Repair) 8201 E. McDowell Road Scottsdale, AZ 85257

The user should include the point of contact's name, telephone number, shipping address (stateside only), item serial numbers, description of failure and tracking number received from the BFT DPM.

Step 2. The Contractor shall email the BFT DPM or designated representative to confirm receipt and obtain authorization to proceed with repairs based on diagnosis and established levels of repair cost categories. If the BFT DPM authorizes the repair, the unit is repaired and the appropriate charge is made to the contract repair line item. If the repair is not approved, the Government shall provide disposition instructions.

Step 3. The Contractor tests, packages, and ships the repaired unit back to the Government (user) at the address provided by the BFT DPM, then emails the BFT DPM to provide shipping details (e.g., FedEx tracking number).

#### 3.0 TECHNICAL DATA

The Contractor shall continue to provide and maintain User's Manuals, flip cards and other technical data to operate and support BFT systems. These materials are currently provided with each end item/system. Updates should be made as necessary with no additional cost to the Government.
