STATEMENT OF WORK

1.0 Scope

This Statement of Work (SOW) defines the effort required to deliver a Flyer Light Tactical All Terrain Vehicle (LTATV) by developing and integrating Special Operations Forces (SOF) peculiar modifications into a modified Flyer Internally Transportable Vehicle (ITV).


2.0 Technical Approach

This program will maximize the Contractor's expertise and experience in advanced mobility technology to modify an existing mobility platform. This program is structured into two phases to develop and incorporate SOF-peculiar modifications. Phase I will develop and incorporate all low schedule risks SOF-peculiar modifications into the base vehicle designated as the Flyer LTATV Gen I. Phase II is an option to develop and incorporate the modifications that add additional capability but require more time and resources. The vehicle provided at the end of Phase II is designated as Flyer LTATV Gen II. This two-phased approach is feasible, low risk, and allows for the progressive introduction of increased LTATV capabilities.

The Flyer LTATV will incorporate these Human Factors and Other Enhancements

- Safety and Comfort
- Ingress / Egress
- Improved Controls
- Improved Vehicle Stability
- Improved Vehicle Safety
- Improved Vehicle Mobility

Integration of SOF Peculiar Modifications Gen I



Specific SOF-peculiar developed modifications will be confirmed by the LTATV Integrated Product Team composed of USSOCOM and Flyer personnel. The IPT will decide the final configuration of the SOF modifications.

The IPT may also consider the following configuration options and exercise the appropriate CLIN for inclusion into the vehicle configuration Gen II.





3.0 Program Requirements

The work required by this contract shall be performed in accordance with this SOW and the requirements listed in BAA 06-BAALTATV. The Contractor shall deliver a Flyer LTATV. The Contractor shall provide program management, design, fabrication required to accomplish the tasks detailed below.

3.1 Integrated Product Team

The Contractor shall establish an Integrated Product Team (IPT) comprised of contractor and customer personnel to determine the final design configuration for the Flyer LTATV. The IPT will validate the proposed vehicle modifications to define the vehicle that best supports USSOCOM LTATV program goals. The IPT will meet throughout the contract period of performance to assess program progress and re-validate the design approach.

3.2 Design

The contractor shall perform design activities to the level needed to develop and integrate the SOF peculiar modifications into the Gen I base mobility platform. Design modification progress will be presented and assessed at scheduled IPT meetings.

3.3 Fabrication

The contractor shall provide the labor and materials necessary to fabricate components, integrate systems, build and deliver one (1) Flyer LTATV to the configuration determined by the IPT.

3.4 Contractor Testing

The contractor shall perform all necessary development system tests to ensure that the Flyer LTATV Gen I successfully integrates SOF modifications as defined by the IPT. As part of this effort, the contractor shall perform a Finite Element Analysis (FEA) and ADAMS simulation to validate the SOF-peculiar modifications that are selected by the IPT and incorporated into the Flyer LTATV.
