

Training Timeline (created by [REDACTED])

Nov 2014 - Three of the four RCMs (Griffin, [REDACTED] had conducted similar overwater missions, BAMBI Bucket operations.

10-12 Feb 15 - Conducted QRF (Quick Reaction Force) and TST (Time Sensitive Target) missions with MARSOC. CW4 Griffin (MOJO 69) and [REDACTED] were the PCs for the flight of two aircraft that conducted the missions.

8-12 Mar 15 - Plan was to conduct overwater missions with MARSOC (HELOCAST, SPIES, Caving Ladder, T-Duck) in both Day and NVG conditions.

Both PCs were involved in the Risk Assessment and Mission Approval briefings prior to leaving their home station. CW4 Griffin did write and get approved an SOP for over water tactical infill/exfill mission tasks (SPIES, HELOCAST, Caving Ladder, Para-drop).

No mission tasks were entered on Griffin, [REDACTED], or Strother's CTL. [REDACTED] had the tasks on his CTL. All of the four CEs had the tasks added, but the CEs in [REDACTED] had old CTLs. No entry that academics had been conducted were on 7122s.

According to both [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] no formal academic classes were conducted, nor was a formal ACMB covering the timeline and tasks to be accomplished ever conducted prior to leaving AASF #1.

9 Mar, both aircraft conducted SPIES training. Each aircraft conducted 2 dry and 2 wet iterations. Each aircraft conducted 2 day iterations of T-Duck. MOJO 69 did NVG iterations of SPIES. Each aircraft did 2 NVG iterations of T-Duck.

10 Mar, MOJO 69 conducted day Caving Ladder, 2 dry and 2 wet iterations. Plan was to conduct one NVG T-Duck iteration for each aircraft.
