Lieutenant Commander J. Daniel Thompson, a native of Arkansas, graduated from Ozark High School in 2001. Thompson was assigned to SEAL Team TEN as a platoon commander. He then deployed to Europe in 2015, and again as a task unit commander in 2017. Following his 2017 deployment, Thompson was assigned as the operations officer for SEAL Team TEN.

Lt. Cmdr. Thompson's military qualifications include Seabee combat warfare officer, Fleet Marine Force qualified officer, and military freefall parachutist. His personal decorations include the Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medal (three awards), Army Commendation Medal, and Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal (two awards).
