

## NAVSCIATTS Executive Officer Biography



**Lieutenant Commander Robert LeClerc**, a native of California, attended the United States Naval Academy and graduated with a Bachelor of Science in Quantitative Economics in 2006, and received his commission as a Surface Warfare Officer.

His first assignment was the USS Halyburton (FFG 40) in Mayport, Florida, where he completed two Counternarcotics Terrorism deployments in the U.S. Southern Command (SOUTHCOM) area of responsibility. He then transferred to Maritime Expeditionary Security Squadron FOUR, completing a deployment in support of U.S. Central Command (CENTCOM) at the Kuwaiti Naval Base, providing shipping security in and out of port facilities.

In 2009, Lt. Cmdr. LeClerc transferred to the Naval Special Warfare community; graduating with BUD/S Class 286. Assigned to SEAL Team EIGHT in Virginia Beach, Virginia, Lt. Cmdr. LeClerc completed one augment to CENTCOM and two deployments to U.S. Africa Command (AFRICOM).

He then transferred to SEAL Team TWO as a Platoon Commander, deploying to Central America in the SOUTHCOM AOR. His follow-on assignment was Operations Officer at Special Boat Team 22, located at the Stennis Space Center along the Mississippi gulf coast, where he again deployed to CENTCOM on a Joint Individual Augmentation assignment.

Lt. Cmdr. LeClerc was named Executive Officer for the Naval Small Craft Instruction and Technical Training School in June of 2019.
