BG Jasper Jeffers graduated from Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University in 1996 and was commissioned as an Infantry officer. His first assignment was Rifle Platoon Leader and Operations Officer in 4-31 Infantry Regiment, Fort Drum, NY. He then served as a Platoon Leader and Executive Officer in 1st Battalion, 75th Ranger Regiment, Hunter Army Airfield, GA.

After Infantry Officer Advanced Course graduation in Fort Benning, GA, he was stationed in Fort Lewis, WA serving as a Company Commander and Air Operations Officer in 1-5 Infantry, 1/25 SBCT. BG Jeffers then served as a Company Commander and Air Operations Officer in 2nd Battalion, 75th Ranger Regiment, deploying multiple times in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom and Operation Enduring Freedom. Following the US Army Command and General Staff Officer's Course at Fort Leavenworth, KS, BG Jeffers then held various leadership and command positions in the US Army Special Operations Command at Fort Bragg, NC and deployed multiple times in support of Iraqi Freedom and Enduring Freedom.



BG Jeffers next attended Senior Service College at Duke University, NC. He then assumed command of 1st Stryker Brigade Combat Team, 2nd ID, 7th Infantry Division. After brigade command, BG Jeffers served as an Advisor to the Commander of Operation Resolute Support in Afghanistan. Upon return to Fort Bragg, he assumed brigade command within the US Army Special Operations Command and deployed in support of Operation Inherent Resolve, Iraq/Syria. Upon relinquishing command, he relocated to Fort Stewart, GA to serve as the Deputy Commander – Maneuver of the Third Infantry Division.

BG Jeffers arrives to assume command of Special Operations Command Central, serving prior as the Deputy Director on the Joint Staff for Special Operations and Counter-Terrorism.

His awards include the Defense Superior Service Medal, Legion of Merit, Bronze Star with Valor, Bronze Star with two OLC, Meritorious Service Medal with one OLC, Joint Service Commendation Medal with one OLC, Army Commendation Medal with four bronze OLC, Army Achievement Medal with two OLC, the Combat Infantry Badge, Expert Infantry Badge, Master Parachutist Badge, Military Freefall Parachutist Badge, Air Assault Badge, and Ranger Tab.
