

## **Command Sergeant Major Michael R. Weimer Senior Enlisted Leader U.S. Special Operations Command Central**

Command Sergeant Major Michael R. Weimer is an Army Special Forces Operator who assumed responsibility as the command senior enlisted leader of U.S. Special Operations Command Central, MacDill Air Force Base, Florida in August 2020 following assignment as Command Sergeant Major, Special Operations Joint Task Force Afghanistan.

Weimer enlisted in the United States Army in 1993. After he successfully completed Special Forces Assessment and Selection in 1994, he graduated the Special Forces Weapons Sergeant Course and earned his Green Beret in 1996.



Command Sgt. Maj. Weimer's previous assignments include tours with 7th Special Forces Group, and 19 years serving within

U.S. Army Special Operations Command (USASOC) including as USASOC's operations (G3) sergeant major. He served numerous tours in the U.S. Central and U.S. Southern Command's area of responsibility and other global missions.

Weimer is a graduate of Norwich University earning a Bachelor of Science in Strategic Studies and Defense Analysis.

His awards and decorations include the Defense Superior Service Medal with C device, Legion of Merit, Bronze Star Medal with two V devices and 5 oak leaf Cluster, the Purple Heart with one device, the Defense Meritorious Service Medal with one oak leaf cluster, the Meritorious Service Medal, the Joint Commendation Medal with V device and oak leaf cluster, the Army Commendation Medal with V device, the Army Commendation Medal with two oak leaf clusters, and the Army Achievement Medal. He has been awarded the Special Forces Tab, Combat Infantryman's Badge, Combat Infantryman's Badge, Military Free Fall Freefall and the Jumpmaster Badge.
