Major General Smith has been assigned to major command air staff and joint level staffs.

Major General Smith has served in key leadership positions to include Commander, 21st Special Operations Squadron, Vice Commander, 27th Special Operations Wing and Commander, Joint Special Operations Aviation Detachment, Bagram, Afghanistan.

Prior to joining SOCEUR, Major General Smith served as the Deputy Commanding General-Operations, NATO Special Operations Component Command/Special Operations Joint Task Force-Afghanistan, Bagram, Afghanistan.
