Andrew I. Harrison Command Master Chief (SEAL/SPECIAL WARFARE)

Master Chief Harrison, from Ft. Lee, Virginia enlisted in the United States Navy in July 1988. He attended basic training at Recruit Training Command and Hospital Corpsman 'A' school in Great Lakes, Illinois. He began his SOF career with United States Marine Corps reconnaissance forces while serving as a Special Operations medic.

He joined Naval Special Warfare (NSW) upon graduating with BUD/S class 201, and reported to SEAL Team TWO (ST-2) in Little Creek, Virginia where he served as Department Representative, Platoon Leading Petty Officer (LPO), and Troop Operations Leading Chief Petty Officer (LCPO). He has served at various SEAL Teams while stationed in Little Creek and he deployed to OEF, OIF, OEF-TS, extensively to the Balkan states, and spent significant time within the European Theater of Operations (ETO) as a Mountain and Artic Warfare Specialist.



He has served as the Command Master Chief / SEL for NSW Special Reconnaissance Team TWO, SEAL Team TWO, and while serving a year with BG James Linder in DCOM-SOF at the NATO Training Mission in Afghanistan.

Master Chief Harrison is currently serving as the Command Master Chief for Special Operations Command, Europe.

His decorations include Bronze Star Medals (with combat distinguishing devices), The Defense Meritorious Service Medal, Army Commendation Medal, Joint Commendation Medals (with combat distinguishing device), Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medals, Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medals, and various unit and campaign awards.
