BG Liller graduated from the University of Miami, FL in 1993 and was commissioned on active duty as an Infantry 2nd LT. Following completion of the Special Forces pipeline, he reported to the 1st Special Forces Group (Airborne) for his first of four assignments with the Group in 1999. He has commanded multiple times at the ODA, Company, Battalion and Group levels. Most recently, BG Liller was the Deputy Commanding General – Operations of the Special Operations Joint Task Force Afghanistan from April 2018 to April 2019.

BG Liller has deployed to locations throughout the world, including Bosnia-Herzegovina in support of Operation Jorge Forge; throughout the Asia-Pacific region in support of Theater Security Cooperation activities; to Iraq in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom and New Dawn; to Central Mindanao, Republic of the Philippines, in support of Operation Enduring Freedom; and to Afghanistan in support of Operation Enduring Freedom.

His military education includes the Infantry Basic and Advanced Courses, the Special Forces Qualification Course, Basic Military Language Course (Russian), U.S. Navy Command and Staff College, and the U.S. Army War College.
