COLONEL JOHN M. ROSS

Colonel John Ross is the Chief of Staff, Special Operations Command-North, Peterson Space Force Base, Colorado. Prior to arriving at Peterson, Col Ross was the Commander, 316th Operations Group, 316th Wing, Joint Base Andrews, Maryland. As Commander, he oversaw the daily operations of two squadrons, a contract maintenance unit, a contract simulator unit, and the employment of 22 UH-1N helicopters tasked with providing continuous contingency response airlift, aviation operations, and flight management support for Joint Base Andrews, joint interagency operations, senior officials in the National Capital Region, and other worldwide customers.

Prior to command, Col Ross was the Director of Strategic Plans and Policy at Special Operations Command-Korea. As USSOCOM's subunified command charged with maintaining the armistice and being prepared to "fight tonight", he ensured US Special Operations Forces and their Republic of Korea counterparts planning efforts are nested into the broader United States Forces Korea and USINDOPACOM Korea family of plans. Prior to Korea, Col Ross was the 58th Special Operations Wing Commander's Action Group director and the Deputy Commander of the 58th Operations Group, both located at Kirtland Air Force Base, New Mexico. He directed training in the MC-130J, HC-130J, HH-60G, UH-1N, CV-22, and MV-22, supervising a \$92M, 23.1 thousand hour flying program at 3 bases with 67 aircraft training 1,200 special operations, personnel recovery, and distinguised visitor airlift students in 22 crew positions.



Raised in Akron, Ohio; Col Ross earned his commission from the United States Air Force Academy in 1999. A Command Pilot with 4,253 flight hours in the MC-130H, U-28A, UH-1N, and HH-60 aircraft, Col Ross has flown combat missions in Iraq, Afghanistan, Philippines, Yemen, and Syria. He commanded the 34th Special Operations Squadron at Hurlburt Field, Florida, employing the U-28A Draco aircraft, and was responsible for global special operations taskings as the Air Force component member of USSOCOM. He commanded, planned, prepared, and executed U-28A missions providing manned fixed-wing ondemand and surge capability for tactical airborne intelligence, surveillance, and reconnaissance and targeting in support of special operations forces

Col Ross is married to the former Stacie Honeycutt of Myrtle Beach, SC. They have one child, Jack.
