

Master Gunnery Sergeant Andrew McCurry Senior Enlisted Leader U.S. Special Operations Command Central

Master Gunnery Sergeant McCurry enlisted in the United States Marine Corps in 1996 as an infantryman and was initially assigned to 3rd Battalion 7th Marines, 1st MARDIV (REIN). In 2000, he was screened and selected for Marine Security Guard Duty and subsequently assigned to U.S. Consulate General St. Petersburg, Russia, and U.S. Embassy Valletta, Malta.

Upon completing Embassy Duty in 2002, Master Gunnery Sergeant McCurry was assigned to 3rd Battalion 6th Marines, 2nd MARDIV. In June 2006, he was screened and selected for duty in the newly established Marine Forces Special Operations Command (MARSOC), where he served in two of the three Raider Battalions. In 2016, Master Gunnery Sergeant McCurry



was selected to serve at Headquarters Marine Corps, Manpower and Reserve Affairs.

In 2019, and upon return to MARSOC, Master Gunnery Sergeant McCurry was assigned as the Special Operations Forces Senior Enlisted Advisor for the Marine Raider Support Group. In February 2020, he was selected to serve as the Command Senior Enlisted Leader for the Special Operations Joint Task Force – Operation Inherent Resolve.

Master Gunnery Sergeant McCurry has deployed in support of campaigns to include Operation ENDURING FREEDOM, Operation IRAQI FREEDOM, and Operation INHERENT RESOLVE. His awards are comparable with Marines of similar service and experience. Master Gunnery Sergeant McCurry holds a Bachelor of Science in Organizational Leadership and Master of Science of Strategic Leadership (Honors) from the University of Charleston. He is also a graduate of the Joint Special Operations University Senior Enlisted Academy, Summit Course, and U.S. Army Sergeants Major Academy. Master Gunnery Sergeant McCurry is married to the former Angel T. Green of North York, Canada, and they have two sons, Connor and Cameron.
